**BYLAW NO. 964**

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF MAYERTHORPE IN THE PROVINCE  
OF ALBERTA TO AMEND THE R.V. PARKING BYLAW NO. 880**

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1, Division 7 and Section 6(1) of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 a municipality may authorize the revision of any or all of the bylaws of a Municipality.

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Town of Mayerthorpe determined it necessary to amend Town of Mayerthorpe R.V. Parking Bylaw No. 880 for the purpose of ensuring that the said Bylaw remains a current document;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Town of Mayerthorpe in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. THAT the definition of “recreation unit or trailer” be amended to read as follows;

**Recreation Vehicle – means a vehicle designed or used for travel with temporary living accommodation for vacations or camping purposes.**

**Trailer means a vehicle so designed that it**

- a) **may be attached to or drawn by a motor vehicle or tractor, and**
- b) **is intended to transport property or persons,**


**and includes any vehicle defined by Alberta regulation as a trailer, but does not include machinery or equipment solely used in the construction or maintenance of highways.**


2. THAT the definition of Peace Officer be amended by deleting the word Special Constable and replacing it with **Community Peace Officer**.
3. THAT any reference to Unit in this Bylaw be amended to read **Vehicle** in keeping with the definition of Recreational Vehicle above.
4. THAT Section 1. be amended as follows;
  - a) Special Constable be replaced with **Community Peace Officer**
  - b) Delete the last sentence and replace with **A Recreational Vehicle or other trailer shall not be parked on any highway unless it is attached to a vehicle by which it may be drawn.**
5. THAT Section 3. be amended to remove Special Constable and replace it with **Community Peace Officer**.
6. THAT this Bylaw becomes effective upon it’s final passing.
