## Mayor's Message

The Town of Mayerthorpe is pleased to present summer programs to provide options due to the closure of the outdoor swimming pool. The Town sent 1,100 surveys to Mayerthorpe and area to seek input into the type of programming the community wanted. In addition, surveys were given to students seeking their input into programs.

This program booklet is a new communication tool to increase awareness of programs being offered in the Town of Mayerthorpe. Please note that these programs are brought to you, the people of the Mayerthorpe community, through funding provided by the Town of Mayerthorpe, Lac Ste. Anne County, and Woodlands County.

Included in the booklet is the Mayerthorpe Exhibition floor plan which outlines either a flexible membrane structure or a pre-engineered structure. Request for proposals were issued on the construction of this building on June 10, 2010. The closing date to receive bids is June 17, 2010. Council will award the construction of this building at the June 28, 2010 regular Council meeting. If all goes well, construction crews will be on site middle of July.

Included in the booklet is the Outdoor Swimming Pool conceptual design plan including the tube slide that has been donated by the Kinsmen Club of Whitecourt. Council will look at this project in greater detail after award of the Mayerthorpe Exhibition Centre Project.

Thank you to everyone who took the time to complete the survey as your input resulted in the enclosed programs being developed!

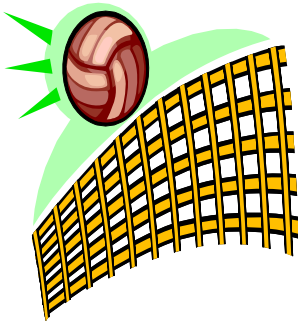

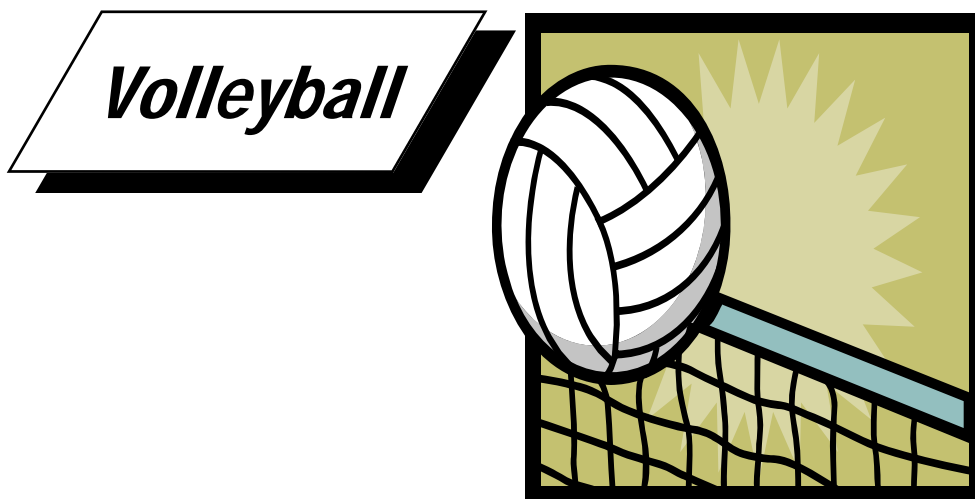

## Exhibition Centre UPDATE

Input into design of the Mayerthorpe Exhibition Centre came from Arena Operating Committee representatives and the Mayerthorpe and Area Regional Planning Committee.

Design upgrades: increased ice surface (85' x 200'), six dressing rooms (2 female), 4 barrier free seating, stadium seating for 303, concert seating capacity 1,400, stock door North wall, rough in future mezzanine, and many structural upgrades including insulation.

Proposals for construction was issued June 2, 2010. The process provides for a value based selection process for construction of EITHER a flexible membrane structure OR a pre-engineered metal building based on +/- 3,200m<sup>2</sup>.

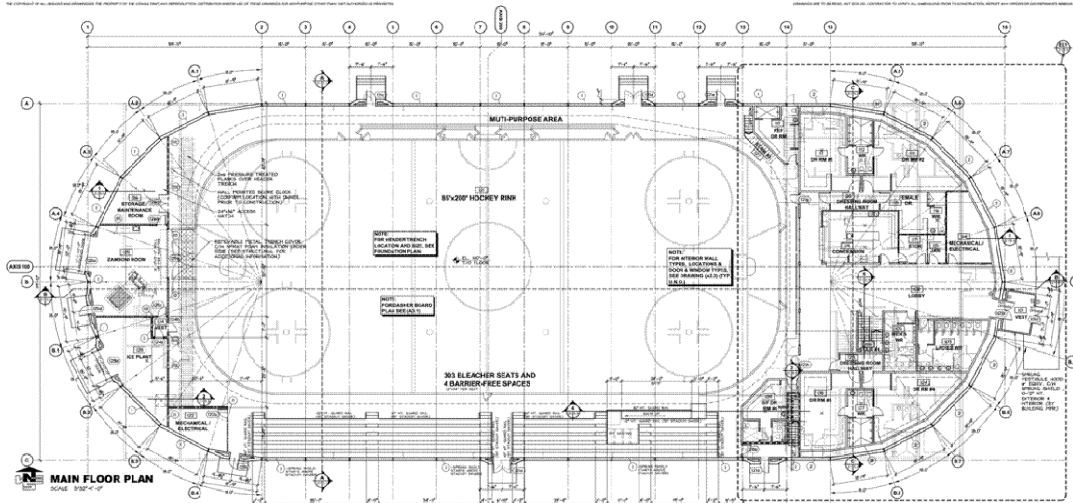
The project was advertised on Alberta Purchasing Connection, COOLNet Alberta, and COOLNet Edmonton in accordance with public procurement requirements.

Closing date to receive proposals was June 17, 2010 4:00 p.m. Proposals to be reviewed on June 25, 2010 and a recommendation given to Council at the June 28, 2010 regular Council meeting. If all goes well, construction crews should be on site as early as July, 2010.

The design in this booklet is not very clear, anyone wishing to look at the design is welcome to stop in at the Town Office and view the plans.

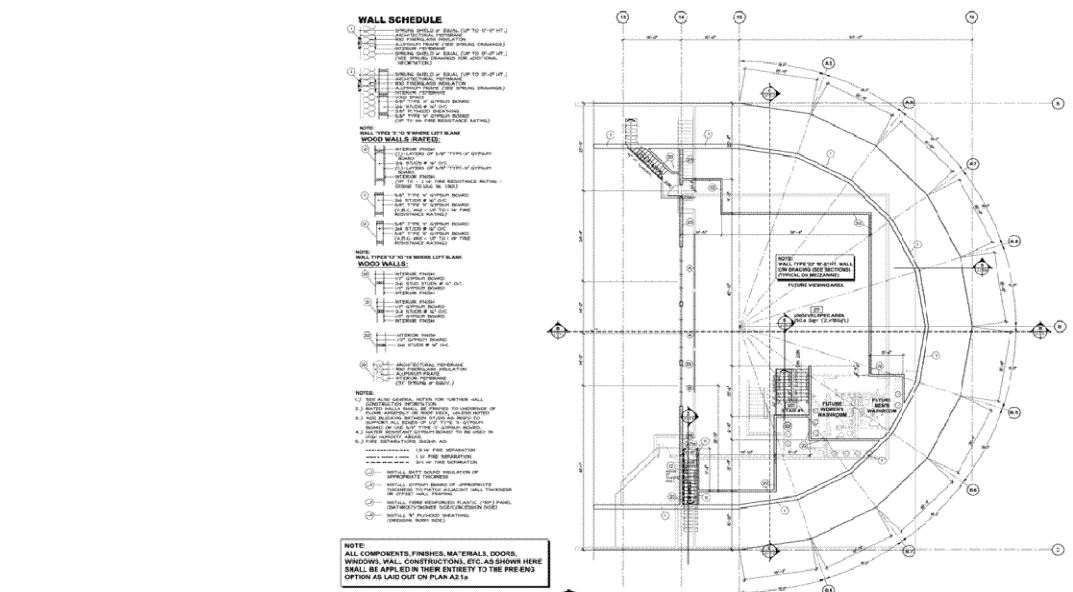

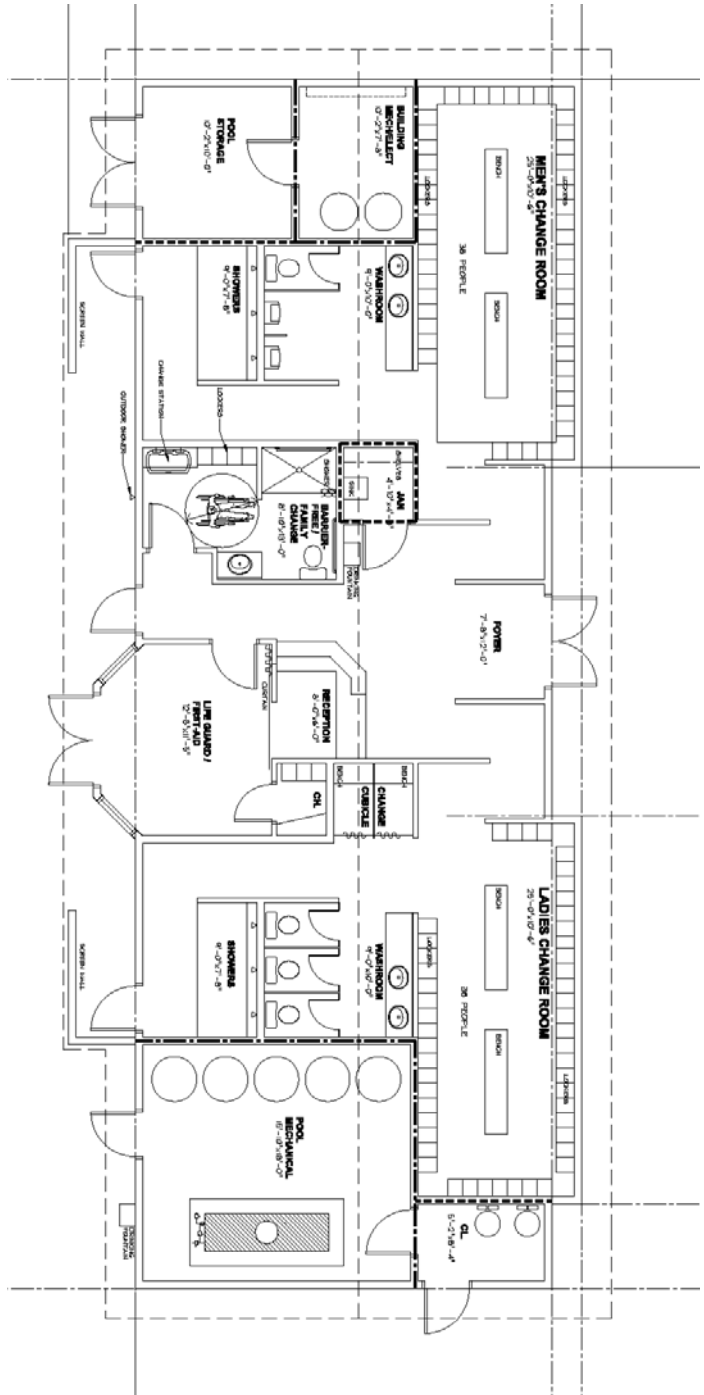
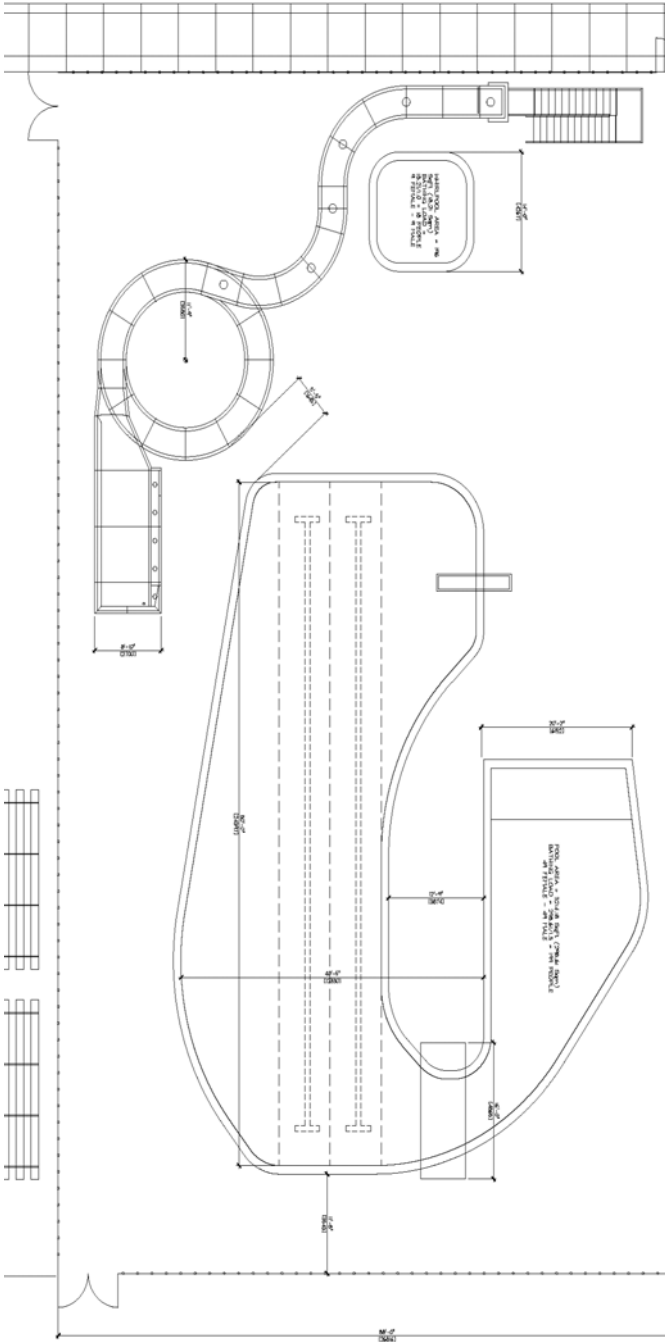

## Outdoor Swimming Pool UPDATE

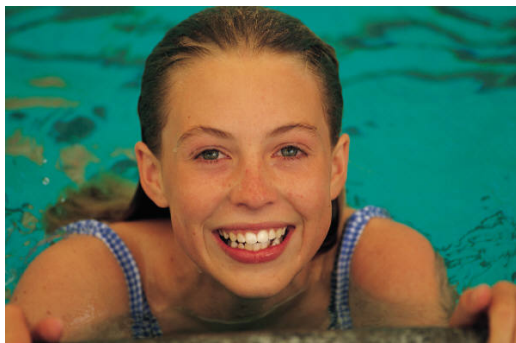
The Outdoor Swimming Pool was officially closed on April 26, 2010.
