Development of a Business Support Network

In order to strengthen the community, and provide an environment where businesses can thrive and grow, the Town of Mayerthorpe's Council recognized the need to support the development of a business support network model within the Town of Mayerthorpe and surrounding areas.

The Business Support Network (BSN) is intended to be an ongoing group of businesses, business organizations, and government, who work within the Town and surrounding areas, to identify and address common operational and human resource issues. The meetings build stronger partnerships within the business community.

The network will work together to:

- Identify common workforce challenges and current labour market trends.
- Address identified trends and challenges, as a group, by exchanging ideas and building partnerships.
- Topics are led by the businesses who attend.

Kristy Tuts, Workforce Consultant with the Ministry of Labour – Employer Services will be in attendance at the March 19, 2018 Policies and Priorities Committee meeting to provide Council with a presentation on the Business Support Network model and start-up initiatives.
