

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the hours of operation of the playgrounds?

There is no set time limit; however, it is recommended from sunrise to sunset.

Who maintains the playgrounds?

FCSS and Recreation department conducts annual inspections of the playgrounds to ensure compliance to playground safety standards and Public Works performs regular maintenance.

Do playgrounds need to meet a specific standard?

Yes, playgrounds are required to meet the National Standard of Canada Children's Plays Spaces and Equipment.

Where do I report suspicious activity at the playground?

You can report suspicious activity to the Town Office during business hours or contact the RCMP directly.

Do my children need to be supervised?

It is recommended that children be supervised at all times as no supervision is provided.

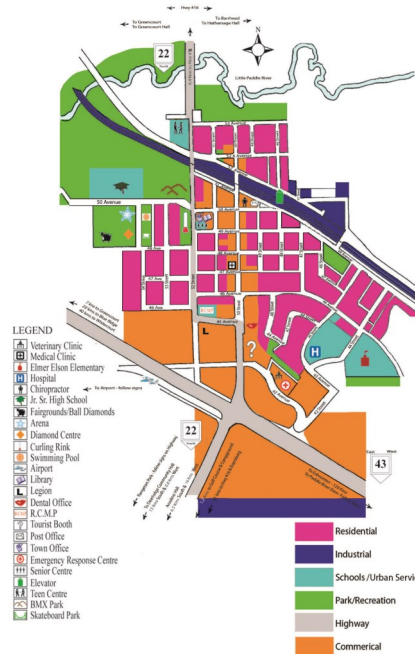
DIRECTIONS

SAFETY TIPS

- Actively supervise children on playgrounds.
- Take your kids to playgrounds with shock-absorbing surfaces such as rubber, synthetic turf, sand, pea gravel, wood chips or mulch. If your child falls, the landing will be more cushioned than on asphalt or concrete.
- Dress appropriately for the playground. Remove necklaces, purses, scarves, helmets with chin straps or clothing with drawstrings that can get caught on equipment and pose a strangulation hazard.
- Teach children that pushing, shoving or crowding while on the playground can be dangerous.
