A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF MAYERTHORPE FOR THE 2022 TAXATION YEAR

WHEREAS, the Town of Mayerthorpe has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the municipal revenue, expenses and expenditures as required, at the Council Meeting held on April 4, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal revenues from all sources other than property taxation is estimated at \$2,762,498 and;

WHEREAS, the estimated municipal expenses (excluding non-cash items) set out in the annual budget for the Town of Mayerthorpe for 2022 total \$4,435,915; and the balance of \$1,673,417 is to be raised by general municipal taxation; and

WHEREAS, the estimates amount required to repay principle debt to be raised by general municipal taxation is \$210,513; and

THEREFORE the total amount to be raised by general municipal taxation is \$1,883,930 and
