BYLAW NO. 1099

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF MAYERTHORPE IN THE PROVINCE OF
ALBERTA TO AMEND LAND USE BYLAW NO. 1066**

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1, Division 5 and Section 692(1) of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 R.S.A., a municipality may amend an adopted Land Use Bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Mayerthorpe determined it necessary to amend Town of Mayerthorpe Land Use Bylaw No. 1066 for the purpose of ensuring that the said Bylaw remains a current document;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Mayerthorpe in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. THAT provisions of the Land Use Bylaw be, and is, hereby amended by adding “manufacturing services” to the list of discretionary uses in Section 129(2).
2. THAT Section 129(4)(b) be added to read as follows:
 - b) That manufacturing services as an industrial use within this Commercial District be subject to the same character and appearance standards as adjoining land uses within the same District.
3. THAT this Bylaw becomes effective upon it’s final passing.

Should any provision of this bylaw be found to be invalid then such invalid provision shall be severed and the remaining bylaw shall be maintained.

READ a third time this 23rd day of April A.D. 2019.
